




ADDING an ELD Event on Android™ Devices



1 Start by selecting **View Log**




2 Select the date of the log needed to edit, then select **Edit This Log**. Optionally, select **Edit Log** on the left and select the log date from there.




3 Select **Add Log Event**.



4 Select the status of the event that is being added and enter, at minimum, **Start Time, End Time, Location,** and **Annotation**. Annotation is a note as to why the status is being added/edited.



5 Select **Apply** to save the event. A success message will be displayed.





6 Status is now added to the log.





2 Select the date of the log needed to edit, then select **Edit This Log**. Optionally, select **Edit Log** on the left and select the log date from there.


3 Select **Edit** next to the status that needs to be edited.



4 Make the necessary changes to the ELD Event. In this case, the end of day off duty status is changing from 4 PM to 3 PM because the driver forgot to logout. The **Annotation** reflects this.



5 Select **Apply** to save the event. A success message will be displayed.



6 The change is now reflected on the log.
